



Foundation Scripture **Hebrews 11:6**

I. **Unbelief....Faith's Rival**

A. **Matthew 17:14-20**

1. Notice what Jesus said... *“Oh FAITHLESS generation...”*
 2. Unbelief is simply that – **Faithlessness** (It is the opposite of faith).
- B. If Faith is (**Now, Believing, Knowing, Speaking, Acting**), the Unbelief is...
1. Not Now (It hopes for the best someday, but never today)
 2. Not Believing (The Truth) – It relies on the 5 senses to tell it what is true where Faith is the evidence of things not seen.
 - This is where the “Second Word” comes into play. Satan will always bring a second word to challenge the First Word of Promise.
 - Faith believes the Living Word of Truth spoken from God; Unbelief wavers with every spoken word in this world.
 3. Not Knowing (The Truth)
 - When you Know that God is for you, the enemy cannot talk you out of your blessing.
 - When you don't know the truth, there is no ground for you to stand upon so that you are able to believe – Satan tries to replace God's knowledge with his.
 4. Not Speaking (The Truth) – Unbelief speaks what it sees, not what it knows!
 5. Not Acting – Faith moves while Unbelief stands still or runs in fear.

II. **Mark 5:21-36**

A. 2 people with faith at its best

1. Jairus' faith (Expected, Believed, Knew, Spoke, Acted)
2. Woman's faith (Expected, Believed, Knew, Spoke, Acted)

B. Your Faith...

1. The Woman Believed....and She Received (Everyone was touching Jesus, but she was the only one that had faith that acted as the CONDUIT that pulled Healing out of Jesus).
2. She Knew It...Jesus Knew It, and there's more: Jesus gave her the opportunity to testify and share her testimony to all of those standing by to seal it (We overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the Word of our testimony!).

C. *“Don't Be Afraid”*

1. The Second Word *“Your daughter is dead...”*
2. ***“Don't be moved by what you hear....Don't be alarmed or allow your emotions to take control. I did not give you this word...man did. I am not the author of confusion, but I AM the author and finisher of your faith; believe Me; believe My Word and you will receive!” (II Timothy 1:7, Psalm 91:3-7).***
